### Hierarchical Coding Category Conditions Review

Affirmant Health Partners has partnered with Episource to collect and review medical records from 2018 and evaluate the capture of Medicare patient health and risk status. The purpose of the chart review is to capture proper Hierarchical Condition Category (HCC) diagnosis codes in order for CMS to appropriately risk adjust our Medicare patients. Episource will identify any areas for improvement in the identification and documentation of diagnosis codes and submit corrections to our codes for those with supporting documentation. Episource has approval from the Federation ACO Chapters to begin accessing medical records from local Epic instances as well as from some independent offices, focusing on reviewing records from September through December 2018.

Beginning November 2019, Andrea Charmley will lead the HCC retrospective coding review program and coordinate Episource working across all Federation ACO Chapters. Affirmant holds weekly meetings with stakeholders to ensure continued progress through the end of the year.

### Top Decisions Made

- 1 The Affirmant Board of Managers and the Federation ACO Board will move to a quarterly meeting cadence in 2020.
- 2 The 2020 Maintenance Budget was approved by the FCC and Affirmant Board of Managers.
- 3 The Post-Acute Care Workgroup approved 2020 tactics: inpatient palliative care and analytics on discharge disposition. The group also approved continuing to explore readying the Federation ACO to apply for the SNF 3-Day Waiver.

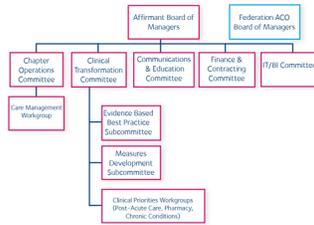

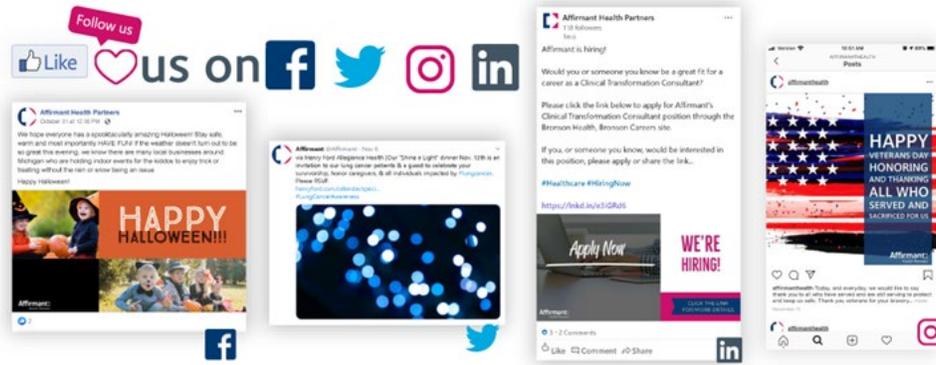
